Computer components (hard drives, monitors, scanners, keyboards); home electronics (TVs, radios, CD and DVD players, etc.); small home and office appliances (copiers, fax machines, microwaves, toasters, printers, dehumidifiers, etc.); and gaming equipment (consoles, batteries, etc.).

Items that are not acceptable include manifested hazardous, radioactive and biohazardous waste, devices that contain mercury, large appliances such as refrigerators, washing machines, and dishwashers, as well as light bulbs.

While helping to make the Men's Final Four green through this e-waste event, LG encourages consumers to replace outdated electronics with ENERGY STAR® certified TVs and computer monitors, which will help save energy and fight climate change.
